

M.K. DAV Public School, Daltonganj Marks Vishwakarma Puja with the Consecration of Its Essential Resources

On the sacred occasion of Vishwakarma Puja , the Institution observed the day with a Havan dedicated to Lord Vishwakarma, revered as the divine architect and the celestial patron of craftsmanship. The ceremony brought a spiritual dimension to the instruments that quietly enable the Institution's everyday functioning.
