A Message from the Principal

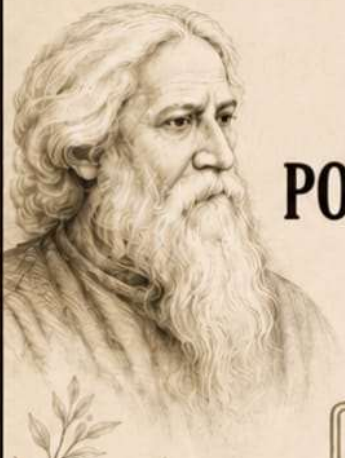
