

Ideas in Motion: Teachers Embark on a Three-Day Academic Journey under the Auspices of DAV CAE

The first day of the three-day Capacity Building Programme brought together educators from different DAV institutions under the aegis of the Regional Training Centre, DAV Public Schools, Jharkhand Zone–B and J. The academic initiative was coordinated by Shri M. K. Sinha, A.R.O., DAV Public Schools, Jharkhand Zone–B and Shri S. K. Mishra, Principal, DAV Public School, Bariatu, Ranchi and A.R.O., DAV Public Schools, Jharkhand Zone–J. Academic guidance was provided by Smt. Kiran Yadav, Principal, Nirja Sahay DAV Public School, Kanke, Ranchi and Cluster Head, DAV Public Schools, Jharkhand Zone–J. To facilitate subject-wise learning, the programme has been distributed across three venues in Ranchi - Nirja Sahay DAV Public School, Kanke, DAV Public School, Gandhi Nagar, CCL, and DAV Public School, Pundag. The arrangement has enabled educators from diverse disciplines to participate in sessions tailored to their academic needs.

An air of intellectual curiosity permeated the venues as participants immersed themselves in conversation on effective pedagogy. Teachers representing different subjects assembled for a series of academic sessions designed to expand professional understanding and facilitate constructive exchanges on emerging educational practices. Throughout the day, participants exchanged classroom experiences, examined instructional challenges and deliberated on ways to make learning more relevant and engaging for students.

The sessions moved beyond the discussion of subject content and ventured into areas that shape the everyday realities of teaching. Questions related to assessment, learner participation, classroom communication and the thoughtful integration of technology formed an important part of the deliberations. The interactive format enabled teachers to contribute ideas freely while drawing insights from the experiences of their peers.

Speaking about the significance of such initiatives, the Honourable Principal, MRS. INDRANI CHATTERJEE observed that schools thrive when teachers are given opportunities to revisit their practices and encounter fresh perspectives. She remarked that education is not a static enterprise as it grows through continuous inquiry and professional exchange. According to her, programmes of this nature create spaces where educators can pause, examine their methods and return to their classrooms with renewed insight. She further noted that every investment in a teacher's growth eventually reaches students, enriching the quality of learning they experience each day.

The opening day concluded on a thoughtful note leaving participants with new questions to explore and fresh ideas to carry forward. As the programme progresses, the coming sessions are expected to broaden these conversations and contribute to a richer understanding of impactful teaching in an evolving educational landscape.
